

## PSALM 2

Links between Psalm 1 & 2:

Another way to outline Psalm 2 is through the action words.

- 2:1-3: The Nations \_\_\_\_\_
- 2:4-6: God \_\_\_\_\_.
- 2:7-9: The King \_\_\_\_\_ His right to rule.
- 2:10-12: The Psalmist \_\_\_\_\_ with us.

### STANZA 1: The World Speaks (2:1-3)

The psalmist expresses amazement (incredulity) that the people of the earth would rebel against God.

**"His anointed"**

### STANZA 2: The Lord Speaks (2:4-6)

**"He ... laughs, the Lord scoffs at them"**

**"I have installed My King upon Zion, My holy hill"**

### STANZA 3: The King Speaks (2:7-9)

**He said to Me: "You are My Son, today I have begotten You."**

Prophetically, this refers to Jesus, who will one day rule over all the universe.

(See also: Revelation 11:15; Philippians 2:9-11; Matthew 28:18-19)

### STANZA 4: The Psalmist Speaks (2:10-12)

We need to give our allegiance to Jesus ... before it is too late!

We need to **worship the Lord with reverence ...**

**and rejoice with trembling.**

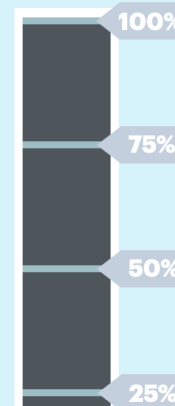
