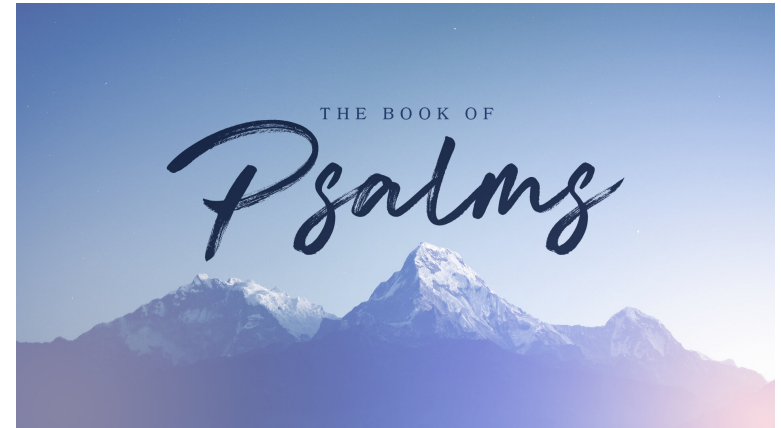


Our next Psalm together will be:

## PSALM 10



## PSALM 8

Psalm 8 is a \_\_\_\_\_ psalm.

### THE GREATNESS OF GOD (8:1,9)

“O Lord, our Lord, how majestic  
is Your name in all the earth!”

- The word **LORD** (Yahweh) means God is the great \_\_\_\_\_!
- The 2nd use of **Lord** (Adonai) emphasizes God’s right to \_\_\_\_\_.
- The word **majestic** indicates someone who commands great \_\_\_\_\_ because of his awesome \_\_\_\_\_.

“Who have displayed Your  
splendor above the heavens.”

- The word **splendor** means magnificent in appearance,

**THE FRAILITY OF HUMANITY (8:2)**

Verse 2 means:

God, by His sovereign grace, has chosen to defeat His enemies by means of \_\_\_\_\_ humanity.

**DAVID'S AMAZEMENT (8:3-8)**

Three Observations:

**God has:**

- made us a little lower than the \_\_\_\_\_ (v.5a).

Psalm 8 may be compared to a theater play.

- God writes and directs the script.
- Prologue: Praise to God for His wisdom and power.
- Cast: God, His people & His enemies.
- Plot: The struggle for universal domination.
- Protagonist: Us when we recognize our need for God.
- Antagonist: Satan and all who oppose God.
- Hero of the story: \_\_\_\_\_
- Outcome: The subjection of all things to Jesus.
- Epilogue: Praise to God for His wisdom and power.

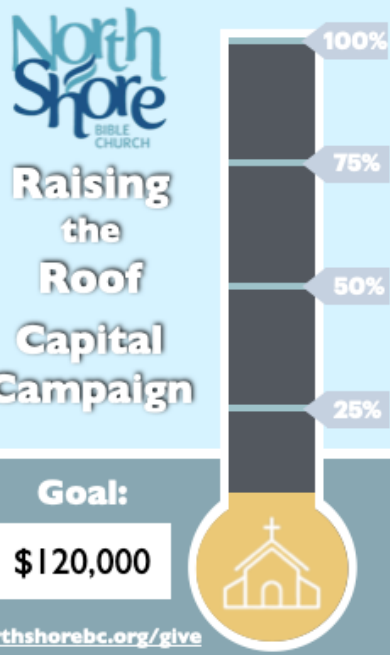

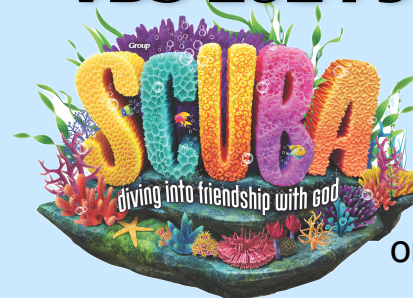
