<u>Title of Study</u>: "The Revelation of Jesus Christ"

<u>Theme of Revelation:</u> The majesty and glory of the warrior lamb, King Jesus, who is coming again to rule and reign forever.

<u>Purpose:</u> To encourage and give hope to the persecuted church and call the church to faithful obedience.

<u>Title:</u> "Back to the Beginning"

Main idea: God will restore things to the way they were in the beginning!

6 Features

- 1. We will regain access to the tree of life!
 - vs (22:1) "pure river of water of life"
 - o It is described as "clear as crystal"
 - o This again is so that the glory of God radiates all of heaven.
 - o This reminds us of Ezekiel's description of the millennial temple.
 - o Ezekiel 47:1-12
 - o vs (9) especially points to the healing and life from it that we see in Revelation 22.
 - o The similarities of the fruit and trees are striking as well.
 - o This pictures eternal life.
 - vs (2) "middle" can be pathway.
 - vs (2) "tree of life"
 - o The emphasis is not on a singular tree but the kind of tree.
 - o In other words there could be a line of trees that are the tree of life.
 - o vs (2) "each yielding its own fruit"
 - A variety of fruits
 - vs (2) "leaves" "healing of the nations""
 - As in our last study, nations can simply mean peoples.
 - o But why healing? Healing from what?
 - O John MacArthur points out that the word "healing" (therapeia) can simply mean health-giving not healing a disease.
 - Our continued good health comes from the leaves. We are not told if we eat them or what.
 - o If we eat this fruit and these leaves it will not be because of necessity but more for enjoyment.

Application

- Genesis 2:9
- Genesis 3:22-24
- Man lost access to the tree of life but God will restore access in the New Jerusalem.

- We will have both eternal and abundant life.
- 2. We will live in an un-cursed world!
 - vs (3) "no more curse"
 - Genesis 2:16-17
 - Genesis 3:14-24
 - Spiritually we have already had the curse removed as believers.
 - Galatians 3:10-14
 - Physically, our bodies and all creation groans and waits.
 - Romans 8:18-25
 - Revelation 22:3 "curse" is gone!
 - Revelation 21:4

Application

- Persevere now with hope!
- We can endure with an eye on heaven!
- 3. We will worship our God perfectly!
 - vs (3) "throne of God and of the Lamb"
 - o Instead of the curse, we have the throne.
 - vs (3) "serve Him"
 - o "serve" (latreuo) which means to serve through worship or worship through service.
 - o We will serve God in all kinds of ways in heaven.
 - John 4:24
 - We are incapable of perfectly doing this now.
 - When we walk in the Spirit we worship in spirit and in truth.
 - o But sometimes our flesh takes over and we don't worship Him perfectly.
 - o Ezekiel 40:3 he measures the temple of the millennial kingdom.
 - In some sense God has always measured off what belongs to Him (even though it all belongs to Him).

Application

- When we get to heaven we will worship perfectly with our singing, but also with everything we do.
- Our heavenly body will live as a living sacrifice.
- 4. We will see God face to face!
 - vs (4) "face to face"
 - o After the fall no one could see Him face to face.
 - o Exodus 33:12-20
 - o Man longs to see Him face to face!
 - o That will be the great highlight of heaven.

- vs (4) "name on foreheads"
 - o This speaks of ownership.
 - o But it also speaks of protection and security.
 - o Combined with "face to face" this all points to a new level of intimacy in our relationship to God that we have never experienced.

Application

- Don't you look forward to seeing God? To seeing Jesus? Face to Face?
- It is beyond imagination.
- 5. We will never see nor desire darkness!
 - vs (5) "no more night"
 - o Were you ever scared of the dark as a kid?
 - o Have you ever been in a cavern and they cut the lights out?
 - o No more fear of literal darkness.
 - o John 3:19
 - o There will not be anymore darkness physically or spiritually in heaven.

Application

- All we will see is the radiance of the light from the glory of God.
- It will be constantly beautiful!
- No more daylight savings time needed.
- No more dark rooms to sleep in needed.
- No more lamps to read by or flashlights for a walk.
- 6. We will reign with God forever!
 - vs (5) "reign forever and ever"
 - Even in the eternal state we will have some kind of responsibilities as we exercise dominion over the new heaven and earth under His rule!

Application

- Even though we don't know specifics this will be a part of our activity.
- Revelation 21:3
- Revelation 22:4
- This is the climax of Revelation! Of the Bible! Of redemption!
