



## **“Extraordinary”**

Luke 6:12-19 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. <sup>13</sup> And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles: <sup>14</sup> Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew; <sup>15</sup> Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot; <sup>16</sup> Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor. <sup>17</sup> And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases, <sup>18</sup> as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed. <sup>19</sup> And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.

### **Main Idea: God chooses to use us to carry out His mission!**

#### **1. God chooses the ordinary to do the extraordinary! (12-13)**
