<u>Title of Study</u>: "The Revelation of Jesus Christ"

<u>Theme of Revelation:</u> The majesty and glory of the warrior lamb, King Jesus, who is coming again to rule and reign forever.

<u>Purpose:</u> To encourage and give hope to the persecuted church and call the church to faithful obedience.

Title: "He Reigns, Part III"

Main idea: When Jesus comes, He will reign on earth!

- There are times in Isaiah when the new heavens and new earth speak of the eternal state and times where it does not.
- This is often the nature of OT prophecy. It often does not distinguish between future events. It can switch back and forth without warning.

- \*At that point, the rest of the dead unbelievers will be judged and cast into the eternal lake of fire.
