

5-Day Devotional: The Year Of Fire

Day 1: The Weight of His Presence

Reading: Exodus 3:1-6 (The Burning Bush)

Devotional: Moses encountered God in a burning bush that was not consumed—thorns aflame yet not destroyed. This year, God invites you to recognize the weight of what you carry: the fullness of the Godhead dwelling within you. Fire represents not God's anger, but His awakening presence. The curse (thorns) meets the fire of His glory, and transformation begins. Have you become casual with the treasure inside you? God's presence is not a small thing tucked away in your heart—it's the consuming fire of the Almighty making His home in you. Today, ask the Holy Spirit to awaken you to the magnitude of who lives within you. Let complacency burn away as you recognize you are a burning bush—a vessel carrying holy fire that the world needs to see.

Day 2: Breaking Agreement with Darkness

Reading: 1 Corinthians 6:15-20

Devotional: Your body is the sacred temple of the Holy Spirit. You were purchased at an expensive price—the blood of Jesus. When we partner with darkness through compromise, entertainment that glorifies evil, or tolerating sin, we take Christ into places He was never meant to go. This isn't about earning salvation through works; it's about honoring the One who chose to dwell in you. What agreements with darkness have you made through self-comfort, self-protection, or apathy? God's refining fire comes this year to expose mixture and bring you into purity. His love is so intense He won't let you stay entangled. Today, ask the Holy Spirit to reveal any area where you've treated His presence casually. Break agreements with darkness and step into agreements with light—you are loved, empowered, and called to carry Him with honor.

Day 3: From Mixture to Purity

Reading: Hebrews 12:25-29

Devotional: "Our God is a consuming fire"—not to destroy you, but to purify you. Fire changes substance and form, removing everything shakable and impure while leaving only what is eternal. God is stripping away powerless religion, half-hearted devotion, and divided hearts. The shaking you feel isn't punishment; it's His passionate love refusing to let anything harm or distract you from your calling. Like gold tested in fire, your faith is being refined and revealed. The contradictions and chaos you face are invitations to partner with the Holy Spirit's

grace—His supernatural empowerment to govern what feels overwhelming. This is your year of becoming. Surrender to the refining process. Let Him burn away neutrality, skepticism, and unbelief. What remains will be pure gold—a faith that shines with His glory and a heart ablaze with holy passion.

Day 4: Ministers of Flame

Reading: Hebrews 1:7; Luke 12:49-50

Devotional: God makes His messengers flames of fire. Jesus said, "I have come to start a fire on this earth—how I wish it were blazing right now!" You are called to be a fire carrier, igniting kingdom life wherever you go. The supernatural realm is hindered by complacency and compromise, but awakened by those who honor what they carry. This year, God is raising up sons and daughters who know how to carry the weight of His fire and kingship—people who will not negotiate with His presence or live on borrowed oil. The world is watching for burning bushes—lives so consumed by God's presence that they cannot be explained naturally. Will you be a minister of flame? Choose today to fan into flame the gift within you. Let your life become a testimony of His supernatural power, drawing others to the fire of His love and transforming presence.

Day 5: Awakened to Union

Reading: Colossians 1:27; 1 John 4:17

Devotional: "Christ in you, the hope of glory." You are not just forgiven—you are united with Christ, one spirit with Him. As He is, so are you in this world. This mystery is the treasure in earthen vessels: the fullness of the Godhead dwelling in clay. God is awakening you this year to the reality of this union. You carry His authority, His love, His power, and His nature. When you step into chaos with this awareness, you bring order. When you enter darkness carrying His light, transformation happens. The answer to a world in chaos is a person in order—someone who knows what they carry. Stop running from contradictions; they reveal the metal of faith already within you. Partner with the Holy Spirit's grace to govern every situation. Delight in His perfecting work. Let your heart soften and be molded into His image. You are a flame of fire, awakened to the weight and beauty of union with Christ. Live like it.
