THE MONSTER: GREED.

Luke 12:15 Then he said, "Beware! Guard against every kind of greed. Life is not measured by how much you own."

HOW TO BREAK FREE FROM THE GRIP OF GREED:

1. LEARN TO LOVE GOD FIRST AND FOREMOST.

Matthew 22:37–38 Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. Matthew 6:24 "No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and be enslaved to money.

2. LEARN TO LOVE OTHERS SECOND.

Matthew 22:39 And *the* second *is* like it: *'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'* Philippians 2:3–4 Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. ⁴ Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.

3. LEARN THE JOY OF LIVING FOR GIVING.

Acts 20:35 You should remember the words of the Lord Jesus: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"
