HOW TO MAKE FRIENDS AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE WITH MY MOUTH

Proverbs 16:28 A troublemaker plants seeds of strife; gossip separates the best of friends.

4. SMILE.

Proverbs 15:13 A glad heart makes a happy face...

Ephesians 6:7 And work with a smile on your face, always keeping in mind that no matter who happens to be giving the orders, you're really serving God.

5. SPEAK TRUTH IN LOVE.

Colossians 4:6 *Let* your speech always *be* with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

Ephesians 4:15 Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.

6. SPEAK WORDS OF LIFE NOT DEATH.
