Avoiding "Sandy Foundations"

Matthew 7:24–27 24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But Everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."

Your foundation Determines your FUTURE.

Action Reflection Question: What are you building your life on today—temporary sand or the solid rock of Christ?

1. Two Builders, Two Foundations

Truth: Knowing the Word is not enough; <u>PRACTICING</u> it makes it a foundation.

Action Point: This week, identify one command of Jesus you know but have not been living out—start practicing it.

2. It was the Storms that REVEAL What's Hidden

- A. You don't rise to the level of your <u>INTENTIONS</u>; you fall to the level of your <u>FOUNDATION</u>.
- Action Point: Don't wait for a storm to test your faith. Daily strengthen your foundation through prayer and obedience.

3. The ROCK is Christ, the Word Made Flesh

Our security is not in WHAT we know but in WHO we know.

- A. What It Means to Build on Him
 - TRUST → Resting your confidence in Jesus, not your own strength. (Proverbs 3:5–6)
 - <u>SURRENDER</u> → Yielding control of your plans, decisions, and future to His lordship. (Luke 9:23)
 - Daily <u>DEPENDENCE</u> → Choosing every day to lean on Him for wisdom, provision, and strength. (John 15:5: "apart from Me you can do nothing")
- B. A Storm-proof life isn't about PERFECTION but about CONNECTION to the unshakable Rock.

Truth: When you build on Christ, you are not Storm-FREE, but you are Storm-PROOF.

Action Point: Each morning this week, declare aloud: "Today I choose to build on Christ, my solid rock."
