## From Reaching to Releasing

**Theme:** The church's role is not just to gather people but to **grow, ground, and guide them** into becoming ministers and missionaries for the Kingdom.

### 1. EVANGELIZE — REACH the Lost

Matthew 28:19–20 (NIV) "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them... and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you."

Romans 10:14 "How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe... unless they are told?"

### **Application:**

- · Be intentional about outreach.
- Teach our church that evangelism is not an event—it's a mission field they walk into daily.

### 2. <u>ASSIMILATION</u> — CONNECT People to the Body

Acts 2:42, 46–47 "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship... and the Lord added to their number daily..."

A. If we Evangelize without Assimilating INTO A CHURCH FAMILY, People DRIFT.

Romans 12:5 (NIV) "So in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others."

• <u>SALVATION</u> is the beginning — <u>BELONGING</u> is the bridge to growth.

#### **Application:**

- Create systems for follow-up, small groups, and new member classes.
- Help people go from sitting to serving and belonging.

### 3. DISCIPLE — GROW Them in Christ

Colossians 2:6–7 "So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in Him, rooted and built up..."

#### Application:

- Develop Bible studies, mentoring, and training paths.
- Move people from being consumers to committed followers.

# 4. <u>UNLEASH</u> — RELEASE Them for Ministry

Ephesians 4:11–12 "...to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ..."

#### **Application:**

- · Help people discover their gifts.
- Release them to serve in the church, in the city, and in the world.

The mission of the Church is movement. From lost  $\rightarrow$  to found; From found  $\rightarrow$  to connected; From connected  $\rightarrow$  to growing; From growing  $\rightarrow$  to going.
