Ephesians 4:14-21 "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, 16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, 17 that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height— 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

1) The POSITION

<u>Verses 14-15</u> "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,"

• The way to access what God has for us is not <u>WORKING</u> harder but <u>SURRENDERING</u> more.

2) The POWER

<u>Verse 16</u> "that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,"

Philippians 4:19 "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

- Our inability to meet our needs is because we're <u>WALKING</u> in the wrong <u>POWER</u>.
- If there is no lack with God, and I find myself lacking, then clearly, I'm pulling from the wrong <u>SOURCE</u>.

3) The PROCESS

<u>Verses 17-19</u> "that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height— 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

- The Love of God TOWARDS me.
- The Love of God THROUGH me towards others.

4) The PROMISE

<u>Verses 20-21</u> "Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, 21 to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen"
