• While obedience to Jesus' words is not a protection <u>FROM</u> the troubles, it is a protection <u>IN</u> the troubles.

<u>Matthew 7:24-27 (TLB)</u> "All who listen to my instructions and follow them are wise, like a man who builds his house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents, and the floods rise and the storm winds beat against his house, it won't collapse, for it is built on rock.

But those who hear my instructions and ignore them are foolish, like a man who builds his house on sand. For when the rains and floods come, and storm winds beat against his house, it will fall with a mighty crash."

• THE ONLY WAY TO PRODUCE A STORM-READY LIFE IS BY FAITHFULNESS AND CONSISTENCY.

<u>Matthew 6:19-21</u> "Do not lay up (store up) for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal, 20 but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

<u>Matthew 6:25-27</u> "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? 26 Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, And yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? 27 And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life?"

<u>2 Thessalonians 3:1</u> "Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times in every way. The Lord be with you all."
