<u>Luke 14:16-18</u> "...A CERTAIN MAN was preparing a great banquet and invited many guests. 17 At the time of the banquet, he sent his servant to tell those who had been invited, 'Come, for everything is now ready.' 18 "But they all alike began to make excuses."

When you connect the <u>SPIRITUAL</u> why with the what, your motivation increases to do what God has asked you to do, which pleases God.

QUIT MAKING EXCUSES

Exodus 4:10-12 "Moses said to the Lord, "O Lord, I have never been eloquent, neither in the past nor since you have spoken to your servant. I am slow of speech and tongue."

- He was looking at his own <u>INABILITIES</u> rather than God's limitless <u>ABILITIES</u>.
- Too often, we diminish God's limitless power by replacing it with our <u>LAZINESS</u>.

Exodus 4:12 "...NOW GO; I will help you speak and will teach you what to say."

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE OBEDIENT?

- 1) DO WHAT YOU CAN DO.
 - Delayed obedience is **DISOBEDIENCE**.
 - OBEDIENCE is the breeding ground for God's favor.
- 2) TRUST GOD TO DO WHAT YOU CAN NOT DO.
 - When you <u>GO</u>, I will help you, and I will teach you.

<u>2 CORINTHIANS 12:9A, 10B</u> "But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness..." For when I am weak, then I am strong."
