Genesis 18:9-15

Doubt isn't the end of FAITH — it's part of the JOURNEY.

- 1) Doubt often comes from... What seems to be <u>DELAYED</u>.
 - Doubt often isn't REBELLION it's FATIGUE.
- 2) Doubt often comes from... What seems to be <u>DEAD</u>.

11 Now Abraham and Sarah were old, advanced in years. The way of women had ceased to be with Sarah. 12 So Sarah laughed to herself, saying, "After I am worn out, and my lord is old, shall I have pleasure?"

- Sometimes, doubt is a defense MECHANISM against DISAPPOINTMENT.
- <u>CYNICISM</u> is often just <u>HOPE</u> that's been wounded.

3) Faith comes from...What we DECLARE.

- Doubt is not the opposite of <u>FAITH</u>.
- The opposite of <u>FAITH</u> is what I <u>SEE</u>.
- Doubt is the "GAP" that we live in of what God's says, and what I see.
- God meets us even when we struggle to HOPE again.
- He does what He says, not because we BELIEVE hard enough, but because He is FAITHFUL.
