Five Lessons to Living The Life God Intends For You To Live

2. Don't Be a Thrill Seeker; Be a God Seeker

• **Test = If Your Goals and Dreams are Taking you further from Christ and His Will, You're on the Wrong Course.**

3. Don't Let Boat People Sink Your Faith

“Lord, if it's you,” Peter replied, “tell me to come to you on the water.”

• **Walking on Water is a Personal Step of Faith.
It's You and Jesus**

4. Use the Faith You Have, and God Will Use It to Accomplish A Miracle.

“Come,’ he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water, and came toward Jesus.”

• God looks for Human Initiative and Response to His Word = Obedience.

5. When you start to sink, Reach For His hand.
