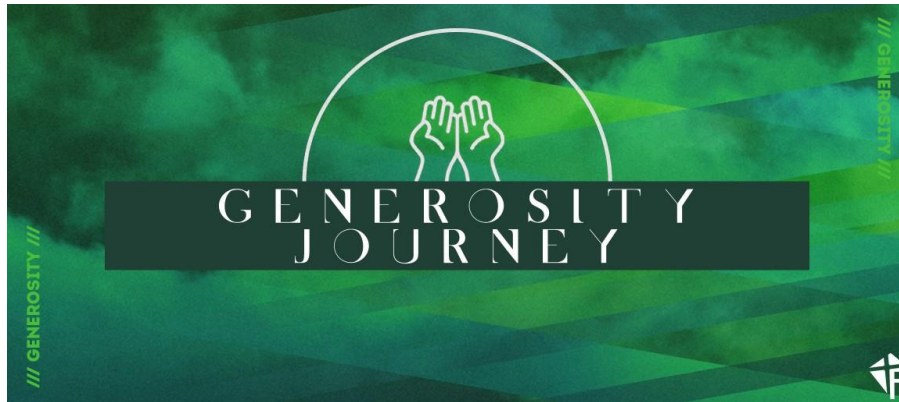

The Leper...

1. Returned and gave _____ to God – Lk. 17:15
2. Fell on his face at the feet of Jesus in _____ – Lk. 17:16a
3. Gave _____ to Jesus – Lk. 17:16b

Steps to Counting Your Blessings and Living Generously – 1 Corinthians 16:2

1. Start with the tithe (10%) to your local church
2. Count your blessings every week and give back a portion of those (a tithe) through generous giving to God and others in the direction the Lord leads.
3. Set aside your giving/generosity funds separately from your living funds (a place, an account, etc.)

What was significant about the one thankful leper? (vs. 16 b) _____

What 3 ways did the leper respond to Jesus for the miracle he had received (vs. 15-16)? What does this indicate about the inner work that was taking place in his heart through this miracle? _____

2. Read together aloud Day 5 in your Devotional or listen to it on the APP.

Review the three Steps Counting Your Blessings and Living Generously from the Sunday morning message notes.

What's the significance of starting with the tithe? (See Proverbs 3:9-10) _____

Why is it important to stop on a regularly basis and count our blessings? What do you think happens if we don't do this? _____

Why is it helpful to set aside funds not just for living but also for giving? What does this enable us to do? How have you seen this work in your life or perhaps you've been on the receiving end of this, how did it bless you? _____

Generosity doesn't just happen. We have to plan for it, be intentional about it, and work at it if we are to grow in it. What has been the most helpful thing you've learned about generosity so far in this emphasis this month? _____
