2. Obey \_\_\_\_\_ .

3. \_\_\_\_\_ your life on Jesus.

### The Church in Corinth: (The "Problem Church")

In chapter 4, Paul is seeking to address and correct the divisions and disunity among the believers.

1. We are called \_\_\_\_\_. Paul understood that serving isn't just something he did but someone he was. (v.1)

Servants = means literally, "under rowers". The lowest of the low.

Don't just serve in a ministry this year, be a servant.

2. We are called to be \_\_\_\_\_ of the Word of God. (v.1-2)

"Be faithful to the Word, no matter what."

3. We need to be careful \_\_\_\_\_ in other's evaluations of us or our ministry. (v.3-4)

4. We need to remember \_\_\_\_\_ is the Lord's. (v.5)

Every believer will stand before the Judgment Seat of Christ, where the things we did for Christ & our motives will be evaluated by the Lord.
