Part 4 - Verse 4

## **Verse 4 provides Three Gurantees Everyone Can Count On:**

1. The guarantee that <u>dark valleys</u> are part of life – vs. 4a Means: *deep, oppressive, lonely, pit-black darkness* 

"My face has grown red with weeping, and darkness covers my eyes." Job 16:16
"Are my days not few? Stop it! Leave me alone, so that I can smile a little before I go to a land of darkness and gloom, never to return. It is a land of blackness like the deepest darkness, gloomy and chaotic, where even the light is like the darkness." Job 10:21-22
"I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. You will have suffering in this world. Be courageous! I have conquered the world." (John 16:33) " Jesus

2. The guarantee that God has promised to <u>lead us through</u> times of darkness – vs. 4b Means: together with, close by, connected to

"...the God of my father has been with me." (Genesis 31:5) ~ Jacob

"Stay with me. Don't be araid, for the one who wants to take my life wants to take your life. You will be safe with me." (1 Samuel 22:23) ~ David to Abiathar the priest

"I will build an altar...to the God who answered me in my day of distress. <u>He has been with me</u> everywhere I have gone." (Genesis 35:5) ~ Jacob

"I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5) ~ Jesus

3. The guarentee that when life is the darkest, every believer can count on the <u>Word of God</u> and the <u>Spirit of God</u> to provide the comfort from God you'll need – vs. 4c

Rod: Represents - the shepherd's strength, power, authority and defense Symbolizes - the Bible
