Jude 3-4

Our Identity in Christ:

- We are His slaves (vs. 1) – Jesus paid for us with His blood on the cross
- We are called (vs. 2a) – We are personally chosen by God to be His child
- We are loved (vs. 2b) – God loved us when we were unlovable
- We are kept – (vs. 2c) – Jesus keeps us secure for all eternity
- We are rich with blessings (vs. 2d) – God's mercy, peace and love

Jude Teaches Us That:

1. All saints (believers in Christ) share a common faith – Vs. 3 (Acts 6:7; 16:5; Col. 2:6-7; 2 Tim. 4:7)
2. Our faith is worth fighting for – vs. 3b (Eph. 2:19-20; Phil. 1:27)
3. Your personal faith is your responsibility and worth investing in – Vs. 3b
