Jude 1-2

Overview of Jude:

- Fourth shortest book in the N.T.
- Written by Jude, the half-brother of Jesus to Jewish believers approximately 65 A.D. during a time like ours when Christianity was under attack externally from the culture and the government, and internally from apostates seeking to infiltrate the church and implant false doctrine
- Only N.T. book devoted exclusively to confronting apostasy, which is a defection from the true biblical faith
- Purpose of writing was to condemn apostasy and apostates and to urge believers to fight for their faith

3. We are _____ (vs. 2b) – God loved us when we were unlovable (Rom. 5:8; Ephesians 2:1-10; Rom. 8:38-39)
4. We are _____ – (vs. 2c) – Jesus keeps us secure for all eternity (Jn. 6:37-40; 10:27-29;
5. We are _____ (vs. 2d) – God's mercy, peace and love (Heb. 4:16; Jn. 14:27)
