

The World's Greatest Sermon - Part 18: "Moment of Truth (Part 1)

Matthew 7:13-20

Theme of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount: Kingdom Citizenship

Spiritual Truths in Jesus' Sermon Conclusion:

1. Most people miss His kingdom, so choose wisely - Matt. 7:13-14

Two Gates:

- 1. The Broad Gate that leads to <u>hell</u>
- 2. The Narrow Gate that leads to <u>heaven</u>

Two Roads:

- 1. The Broad Road is <u>man's</u> righteousness people trying to get to heaven on their own even with religious actions depending on self instead of God.
- 2. The Narrow Road is <u>God's</u> righteousness people on this road are depending totally on what Christ did in dying for our sin on the cross.

Two Destinations:

- 1. Heaven which is eternal life with God
- 2. Hell which is eternal damnation and suffering apart from God

Two Groups of People:

- 1. Those on the <u>broad road</u> those who believe they are on the right path but are deceived this is the majority of people today.
- 2. Those on the <u>narrow road</u> a small minority of people because Jesus says, "few find it" (vs. 14)

2.Be on guard against false prophets - Matt. 7:15-20

False prophets are:

- 1. <u>Heretics</u> those who defy and stand against biblical truth Titus 3:10; 2 Peter 2:1; 1 Cor. 11:19
- 2. <u>Apostates</u> those who know the truth but reject it; those who depart from the faith 1 Tim. 4:1; Heb. 3:12; 10:35-38; 2 Peter 2:15
- 3. Deceivers those who deceive others into not believing truth 2 John 7ff
