

What does the Holy Spirit do?

The Holy Spirit...

- 1. Convicts the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment John 16:8
- 2. Guides us into all truth John 16:13
- 3. Glorifies and testifies of Christ John 15:26; 16;14
- 4. Leads us Romans 8:14; Galatians 5:18; Matthew 4:1; Luke 4:1
- 5. Sanctifies us 2 Thessalonians 2:13; 1 Peter 1:2; Romans 5:16
- 6. Empowers us Luke 4:14; 24:49; Romans 15:19; Acts 1:8
- 7. Fills (controls) us Ephesians 5:18; Acts 2:4; 4:8
- 8. Teaches us to pray Romans 8:26-27; Jude 1:20
- 9. Bears witness in us that we are children of God Romans 8:16
- 10. Produces in us the fruit or evidence of His work and presence Galatians 5:22-23
- 11. Gives us spiritual gifts to build up the body of Christ and glorify God Romans 12; 1 Corinthians 12
- 12. Is our guarantee and deposit of the future resurrection 2 Corinthians 1:22; 2 Cor. 5:5
- 13. Seals us until the day of redemption Ephesians 1:13; 4:30
- 14. Gives us joy 1 Thessalonians 1:6
- 15. Comforts us John 16; Acts 9:31

What Are Spiritual Strongholds and How Are They Overcome? By STANDING IN THE GAP!

Spiritual Stronghold: an area of a person's life that functions contrary to God and His Word; a place in a person's life where Satan holds the person in bondage, and they can't seem to break free from, such as anger, hatred, depression, anxiety, doubt, unbelief, sexual addition, lust, perversion, pornography, food addiction, gambling, gaming, drugs, habits of all kinds – anything that dominates a person's life and enslaves them.

"I searched for a man among them who would build up a wall and stand in the gap before Me for the land...but I found no one." Ezekiel 22:30

Intercessory Prayer: the action of a person who regularly goes to God in prayer for themselves or someone else, continually praying and believing that Almighty God can and will break the stronghold that Satan has over them.

2. Here is a biblical truth in relation to our identity in Christ...

Biblical Truth: Every born-again follower of Christ is considered to be <u>"in Christ"</u>. Being in Christ serves as the position from which all spiritual warfare is fought. To be in Christ is both a <u>position</u> we receive at salvation and a practice we exercise moving forward from salvation.

Read aloud the following verses that describe us as "in Christ"...

"So, you too consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus." Romans 6:11

"Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus." Romans 8:1

"Therefore, if anyone is <u>in Christ</u>, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, and see, the new has come!" 2 Corinthians 5:17
