Part 10: "The Second Coming of Christ" - Revelation 19:11-16

Introduction

The Second Coming of Christ is the central focus of Bible prophecy. The New Testament contains 321 references to the second coming of Christ, second only to its teaching on the doctrine of salvation. This event is referred to in many of the Psalms, all the O.T. prophets, all of the apostles, and by Jesus himself on numerous occasions (at least 21 times). For every verse predicting Christ's first return there are eight that predict his second return. All nine New Testament authors mention it in 23 of their 27 books. It is obvious that God intended for the world to be prepared for the return of His Son and His people to be motivated to holy living and the making of disciples among all nations by the study of the second coming of Christ.

New Testament Overview of Christ's Coming
