WILL OF GOD

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the **will of God** in Christ Jesus for you.

1 Peter 2:15 For this is the **will of God**, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people.

1 Thessalonians 4:3-4 For this is the **will of God**, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor...

Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the **will of God**, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know **the plans I have for you**, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

WORD

John 1:1 In the beginning was the **Word**, and the **Word** was with God, and the **Word** was God.

Psalms 119:105 Your **word** is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

2 Tim. 3:16 All Scripture is **breathed** out by **God** and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness...

Hebrews 4:12 For the **word of God** is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Ephesians 6:13-17 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the **word of God**...

WAIT

Isaiah 40:31 ...but they who **wait** for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

WILL IN NEUTRAL

Matthew 6:10 Your kingdom come, **your will be done**, on earth as it is in heaven.

Matthew 26:39 And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but **as you will**."

CIRCUMSTANCES

Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these **things** will be added to you.

PRAYER

Matthew 6:6 But when you **pray**, go into your room and shut the door and **pray** to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

Jeremiah 29:12-13 Then you will call upon me and come and **pray** to me, and I will hear you. You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart.

Phillipians 4:6 ...do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by **prayer** and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him **ask God**, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

PEACE OF GOD

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Phillipian 4:7 And the **peace of God**, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

2 Peter 3:8-9 But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. John 6:38-40 For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the **will of him** who sent me. For this is **the will of my Father**, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

Hebrews 13:20-21 Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, equip you with everything good that you may do **his will**, working in us that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever.
