- 1. What John *knew* (1:5-7).
 - The *prophet* The Faithful witness.
 - The **Priest** The First Begotten of the Dead.
 - The *King* The Prince of the Rulers of this Earth.
 - The One who *loved* us.
 - The One who **washed** us.
 - The One who *made* us.
 - The One who is *coming again*!
- 2. What John *heard* (1:10).
 - John "heard" because he was in a *position* to hear.
 - John "heard" the Lord commission him to write (2 Peter 1:20-21).
- 3. What John *saw* (1:12-20).
 - Seven churches, with Christ in the *midst*.
 - A garment down to the foot a *celebrity*.
 - A golden belt His *rank*.
 - Head and hair white as snow *perfect righteousness*.
 - Eyes like a flame of fire *judgment*.
 - His feet of fine bronze no prisoners to be taken.
 - His voice as the sound of many waters totally *captivating*.
 - In His hand are held the *pastors* of the seven churches.
 - His mouth a sharp two-edged *conqueror's* sword.
 - His countenance *Glory*.
- 4. What John *did* (1:17-18).
 - He *fainted*.
 - (1) We need not fear life for Jesus is the *Living* One.
 - (2) We need not fear death for Jesus has *Conquered* death.
 - (3) We need not fear eternity for Jesus has the keys.
 - He <u>worshipped</u>!
