Paul's Blueprint for Evangelism 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

Paul was intentional in reaching people for Christ...

- 1. In *adding value* to lost people (v.19-20).
 - He voluntarily became a *servant* to lost people.
 - His blueprint was one of *respect* before relationship.
- 2. In including *everyone* (v.19-23).
 - "Whoever" involves a *wide range* of people (John 3:16; 1 Cor.6:9-11).

How hungry are we for everybody to come to Christ?

- God loves people <u>"I don't like!"</u>
- Paul's blueprint was to *connect* **before** he would correct.
- Paul's blueprint was to focus on <u>WHO</u> versus what we're against.
- God does not *change* us to accept us; He *accepts* us to change us!
- Lost is *Lost*!

I believe that the lost go to hell but I live most of my life like it really doesn't happen. \sim Pastor Tom Pendergrass

- 3. In knowing *who we are* in Christ!
 - Paul's blueprint was that he didn't take on their way of life. He kept his spiritual *bearings*.
 - We don't have to be "like" the lost to reach them, but we do have to <u>"Like"</u> them.
 - When you change a *culture* you know who you aren't.
 - You *keep* yourself holy while *connecting* to their world.

Are people asking me about the hope I have within me?

4. Paul's blueprint was to *enter* their world.

- We (the church and as individual believers in the body of Christ) want "lost" people to enter <u>"my"</u> way and my world.
- I have to enter *their* world.
- I can continue to talk about how bad they are or I can choose to have my heart *break* for the lost.
- The closer you get to lost people the more you will *love* lost people.
- The closer I get to lost people the closer I get to *Jesus!*
- You must "*Catch*" a fish before you can "*clean*" a fish.
- We lose our *passion* and our *compassion* when we don't hang out with lost people.
- 5. Paul's blueprint was to *experience* things from *their* point of view.
 - Do I want to <u>"know"</u> them or do I want them to know me?
 - I must know them before I can *show* them (Acts 17:16-31).

...He who wins souls is wise. ~ Proverbs 11:30

- 6. Paul's blueprint was to *creatively* move people toward God.
 - In the DNA of creativity there's always an *answer*.
 - Passion + Creativity = <u>reaching the lost</u>.
 - Make someone <u>hungry</u> for what you have and the hope that is within you!
- 7. Paul's blueprint was in *sharing* God's message and then *experiencing* God at work.
 - Your *greatest* experience with God will be with lost people.
 - When lost people move *toward* God.
 - *<u>Miracles</u>* happen with *lost* people!
 - Nothing *eternal* is done without Jesus and the lost!
