No water (Luke 16:24).

Eternal Fire (Mark 9:43; Matthew 25:41).

No escape (Luke 16:26).

Memory retained (Luke 16:27-31).

Eternal darkness (Matthew 8:12; Jude 13).

Weeping (Matthew 8:12).

Gnashing of teeth: hatred is the atmosphere (Matthew 8:12).

No known system of transportation (Revelation 20:15).

No provision for salvation again (John 3:18; 3:36).

Hell was prepared for someone else (Matthew 25:41).

Hell and the lake of fire are not the destruction of life, but the second death (Revelation 20:13-14).

In hell, there is no ruler to turn to (Isaiah 14:9-11; 15-16; Ezekiel 28:18-19).

No babies or young children in hell (2 Sam 12:21-23; Psalm 139:16).

Unanswered prayer (Luke 16:24).

Excuses (Luke 16:30).

The inhabitants of hell don't want their loved ones to come there (Luke 16:28).

Hell will expand itself in the future (Ezekiel 28:18).

Jesus has the keys (Revelation 1:18).

The location of hell (Job 38:10).

The inhabitants of hell (Rev 20:10; 2 Peter 2:4; Rev 21:8).

The eternal body of the unbeliever.

There are different degrees of punishment in hell (Luke 20:45-47; 10:14).

Hell is a place of everlasting shame and contempt (Dan 12:2).

There is no rest in hell (Revelation 14:10-11).
