What about the "parachurch" and the "local church"? It is clear from Scripture that God has chosen as the focal point of His ministry today (Eph. 4:7-16; 1 Tim. 3:15), including missions. Any missionary agency or parachurch ministry following this biblical blueprint must view itself as a servant and not sovereign to those churches. The mission's existence must serve to enhance and facilitate this divine model and mandate given to the local church, not vice versa.
