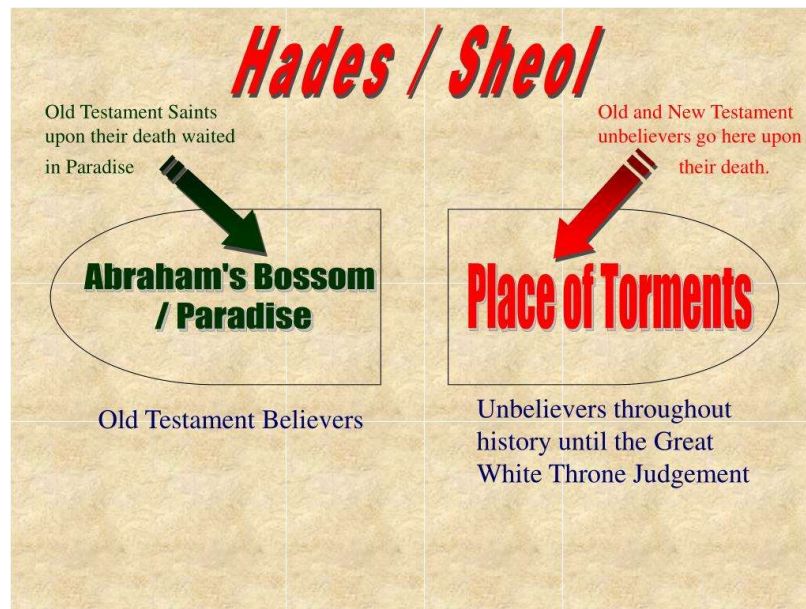


## DISTINGUISHING THE HELLS OF THE BIBLE, Part 1

### I. \_\_\_\_\_ ARE THE MOST COMMON WORDS TRANSLATED AS HELL

#### A. Its DESIGNATION

1. "Sheol" is the Hebrew word for the \_\_\_\_\_ of the earth and can refer to the \_\_\_\_\_ or the place of \_\_\_\_\_. (Habakkuk 2:4-5; Jonah 2:2)

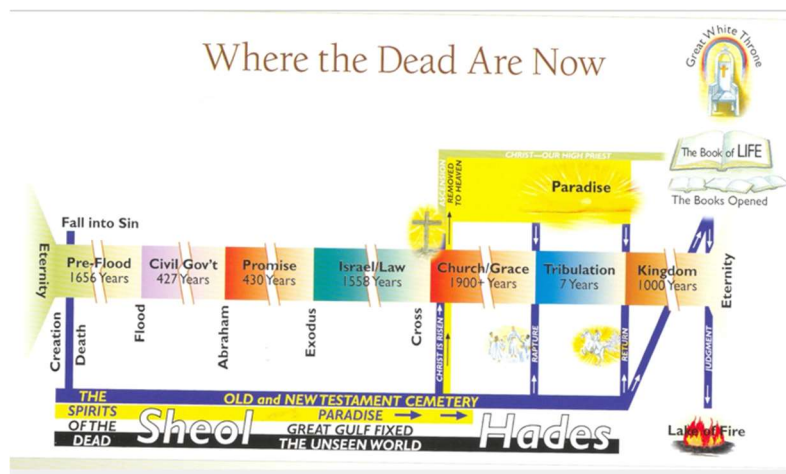
How do we know that Paradise was moved from Hades to Heaven? (Ephesians 4:7-10)

- \* With what multitude of captives then did Christ ascend?

- \* To where did Christ ascend with these captives?
- \* Paul confirms this location for Paradise. (2 Corinthians 12:1-4)
