2.	Regarding ASSOCIATION With Family or Fellowship		
	a.	Positional forgiveness is associated with the family of God (Ephesians 1:7; 4:32).	
	b.	Parental Forgiveness is associated with with God (John 13:6-11; 1 Corinthians 11:30-32; 1 John 1:3-10).	
3.	Regarding REQUIRMENTS		
	a.	For Positional Forgiveness, is required (Acts 10:43; 13:38-39; 26:18).	
	b.	For Parental Forgiveness,/ of sin is required (Luke 15:11-24; 1 John 1:9).	
4.	Re	garding RECEPTION	
	a.	Positional Forgiveness is received by believers in Christ (Colossians 1:14, 2:13, 3:13).	
	b.	Parental Forgiveness is only received by / believers (Acts 8:22; Proverbs 28:13).	
5.	Regarding NECESSITY		
	a.	Positional Forgiveness is needed to go to in the (1 Corinthians 6:9-11).


