2 Questions to ask:

Go Deeper:

1. Read through Judges 6:17-27. Have you ever read the story of Gideon before? What stands out to you the most about this section of verses?
2. Gideon asked for a sign from God to confirm that it was Him speaking. Do you think it was right or wrong of him to ask? Why or why not? Have you ever had to ask for confirmation about something you felt God was directing you towards? Are there times you shouldn't need to ask for clarification from God? Give an example.
3. What things came together that showed Gideon that it was actually God speaking to him? Think about times in your life God was communicating to you, did you have multiple areas of confirmation? Do you feel like that's normal and healthy? Why or why not?
4. Once Gideon confirmed that it was God directing him and he was ready to listen, how long did God wait to give him his instructions? Why is that important? What does that teach us about God and the ways we should respond to Him?
5. Gideon was instructed to destroy the altar to Baal and then replace it with an altar to the Lord. Why do you think this was important? What lesson does this teach us about our own lives? What's one ungodly thing you need to remove from your life? What Godly thing will you replace it with? Who can you ask to hold you accountable in this?
