### Go Deeper:

1. What do you think of when you think about the idea of “Freedom”? Why do you think that is? Biblically, what is the freedom that Jesus brings us? What ways might mainstream culture and politics have diluted or distracted from Jesus’ message of freedom?
2. What ways do you think the Jewish people of Jesus’ time misunderstand the freedom the Messiah would bring? How did what Jesus was talking about differ from their version of freedom?
3. What do you think of when you hear “the eternal perspective”? How is this perspective important to your daily life and faith? How does this perspective change your view and understanding of freedom?
4. Jesus said He was bringing freedom from slavery and would set the captives free. How has this looked in your own life? What would you say to someone who was struggling in slavery to sin?
5. Part of the freedom we are made for is freedom from guilt and shame. Have you struggled with carrying feelings of guilt and shame? How does Jesus’ message of freedom help alleviate some of those feelings for you?
6. What do you think about the idea of being made for freedom through obedience? Does that sound contradictory? Why or why not? How have you seen this play out in your life?
7. Read through the Bible verses above. Which one stands out to you the most and why?
