Go Deeper:

5. What was the purpose for adding the final line to the prayer? How does ending our prayer like this help us realign our hearts and minds? Are there any areas of your life you need to realign with God’s heart?
6. Why is it important that we praise God? How does this final line help us to do that?
7. Is submission hard for you? Why or why not? What do you think it means to “submit” to God?
