5. Read Romans 8:24 and 1 John 2:1. What truth is this conveying to us? Do you believe that Jesus is moving on your behalf? Why or why not? Can you share a story about a time that Jesus moved in your unraveling?
6. What do you think might have happened if Peter had swallowed his pride and listened to Jesus’ warning? Do you believe that sin is rooted in pride? Why or why not?
7. Where are you at right now? Do you feel unraveled? How can you give that to Jesus? If you’re feeling strong, what ways can you move forward and stay “alert” like Peter suggests?
