### Go Deeper:

3. What do you think it means to deny yourself and take up your cross? Why is it so hard to do? Are there any areas in your life you feel convicted to deny yourself?
4. What was the first characteristic of Jesus? Why is that important to us? What ways can you improve in this area? How would you describe the difference between heart change and behavior management? Why is this an important distinction to make?
5. What was the second characteristic of Jesus we looked at? Why is this important to us? Is this a hard area for you? Why or why not?
6. What was the third characteristic of Jesus? Does this seem like a no brainer to you? Why or why not? How does Jesus’ love encourage and convict us to love?
7. Look at the Progression that we talked about. Do you agree with the way that it’s laid out? Why or why not? What area in your life do you need to better emulate Jesus?
