



Acts 20:24 – Dan

Read & Reflect

READ:

- Acts 20:17–24, Romans 10:9–13, Ephesians 4:29

Every person has a story, and every story contains both moments of joy and seasons of struggle. In Acts 20, Paul reflects on his life not through the lens of accomplishments, but through the grace of God that shaped his journey and gave it purpose. As you read these passages, consider how God's grace has been at work in your own story and how He might use it to point others to Jesus.

Understand the Moment

As Paul prepared for the final season of his ministry, he summarized his purpose in one powerful statement: "I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace." (Acts 20:24)

Paul understood that his life wasn't ultimately about comfort, success, or reputation. It was about faithfully telling the story of God's grace. Dan shared how this verse became a defining anchor in his own journey. Through loss, family struggles, rebellion, forgiveness, and calling, God's grace continued to shape his story.

The same is true for us. Every follower of Jesus has a testimony. Not because our stories are perfect, but because God's grace is powerful. The question isn't whether you have a story. The question is whether you're willing to tell it.

Process Together or Alone

- What part of Dan's story resonated most with you?
- Why do you think stories are such a powerful way to communicate God's grace?
- How has God's grace changed your life?
- What fears keep people from sharing their testimony?
- What would it look like to make God's grace the defining theme of your story?

Follow Jesus This Week

Listen

- What part of your story is God inviting you to revisit with gratitude?
- Where do you need to hear God's voice more clearly through Scripture?

Obey

- What is one step of obedience God is asking you to take this week?
- How can you intentionally spend time listening to God through His Word?

Share

- Who needs to hear your story of God's faithfulness?
- What part of your testimony could encourage someone else right now?

Care

- Who do you know that needs to experience God's grace?
- How can you pray for opportunities to share hope with others?



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Live It Out

Take 15 minutes this week and write your faith story.

Include:

- Life before fully trusting Jesus
- How God pursued you
- What changed
- How God is still changing you today

Then pray for one opportunity to share part of that story with someone this week. Remember: *You don't need a perfect story. You simply need a faithful God—and you already have one.*

Pray

- Thank God for specific moments where His grace met you in difficult seasons.
- Confess any fear, shame, or insecurity that keeps you from sharing your story.
- If you don't have one, pray for an impactful “life verse” you can turn to daily.
- Pray that Lighthouse Fellowship would be a church filled with stories that point people to Jesus.

God, thank You for Your grace that continues to transform my life. Help me hear Your voice through Scripture, trust Your work in my story, and boldly share what You have done. Use my life to point others to Jesus. Amen.
