WEEKLY COMPANION

SERVICE COMPANION

This service opened with the joy of redemption, moved through communion and response, and centered on Jesus' mission in Luke 19:1-10. In the story of Zacchaeus, the church was invited to see that Jesus does not wait for the lost to clean themselves up. He moves toward them, knows them by name, and changes them by grace.

Main text Luke 19:1-10	Series Mission Possible
Anchor text Mark 10:45	Weekly aim To understand Jesus' mission more clearly and respond with faith, repentance, and witness.

KEY TRUTHS FROM THE SERVICE

- Jesus came not to be served, but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many.
- People we assume are far from God may already be under the quiet work of God.
- Jesus does not merely notice the lost. He moves toward them, calls them, and enters their lives.
- Real salvation bears visible fruit in repentance, generosity, and a new allegiance to Christ as Lord.
- The mission of Jesus also becomes the mission of His people.
