- 1. Read Gal 2:19-21. In vs. 21 Paul says that he does NOT nullify the grace of God. What kind of activity (or thought) would (or could) possibly nullify the grace of God?
- 2. We've covered these verses over the past two sessions. What remaining questions do you have regarding any of these verses?

Post-Video Discussion

- 1. Did anything stand out to you in the teaching?
- 2. Mark said in the video that (according to vs. 21) that when we seek to be right with God because of our good works that we are declaring that "Christ died for no purpose." Explain why that is the case and whether it is helpful for you to be reminded of this.
- 3. Paul says in vs. 21 that "if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose". Isn't a person more righteous when they keep God's Law? What does this mean?
- 4. Using only Gal 2:15-21, how would you counsel (or encourage) the following people:
 - The person who questions that they might not be saved.
 - The person who says that they are constantly overwhelmed with guilt because of their actions.
 - The person who continues in a sinful lifestyle because they are "living under God's grace".
