Pre-Video Discussion

1. What is the difference between ignorance and foolishness? Is foolishness a sin?
2. Read Galatians 3:1 and talk about anything that stands out to you.

Post-Video Discussion

1. What stood out to you most, from the teaching?
2. How did Mark define "foolishness" in the video? Why does Paul say that the Galatians are being "foolish"? Is what they are doing sinful?
3. Is it helpful to think of yourself as "foolish" when you are working for your right standing before God? Why is "foolish" better than other ways that we might describe ourselves when we are doing that?
4. Paul rhetorically put forth the idea that a spell might be behind their unwillingness to walk according to Gospel truth. What are the reasons that we put forth when we fail to walk according to Gospel truth? Are any of our reasons more reasonable than Paul's ?
