Luke 19:1-10




#### LUKE 19:1-10

**19** Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. <sup>2</sup> And <sup>[a]</sup> there was a man called by the name of Zaccheus; he was a chief tax collector and he was rich. <sup>3</sup> Zaccheus was trying to see who Jesus was, and he was unable due to the crowd, because he was short in stature. <sup>4</sup> So he ran on ahead and climbed up a <sup>[b]</sup>sycamore tree in order to see Him, because He was about to pass through that *way*. <sup>5</sup> And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and said to him, "Zaccheus, hurry and come down, for today I must stay at your house." <sup>6</sup> And he hurried and came down, and received Him <sup>[c]</sup>joyfully. <sup>7</sup> When *the people* saw *this*, they all *began* to complain, saying, "He has gone in <sup>[d]</sup>to be the guest of a man who is a sinner!" <sup>8</sup> But Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I am giving to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone, I am giving back four times as much." <sup>9</sup> And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. <sup>10</sup> For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

He cared about the religious folk (MOB)

# LUKE 19:5

### "Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for today I must stay at your house."

# Come down out of the tree!

# "Come down immediately"

When Jesus calls, we ought to respond immediately!!

### Jesus called you!

#### Did you answer?

 Did you come immediately? 

# Jesus COVERED

# LUKE 19:6-7

<sup>6</sup> And he hurried and came down, and received Him <sup>[c]</sup>joyfully. <sup>7</sup> When *the people* saw *this*, they all *began* to complain, saying, "He has gone in <sup>[d]</sup>to be the guest of a man who is a sinner!"

### If he is with Jesus, what could the MOB do to him?

Jesus was covering him!

Salvation came to Zacheus and his household

LUKE 19:9

<sup>9</sup> And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. <sup>10</sup> For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost." His salvation blessed the MOB

LUKE 19:8

<sup>8</sup> But Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I am giving to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone, I am giving back four times as much."
