Ecclesiastes

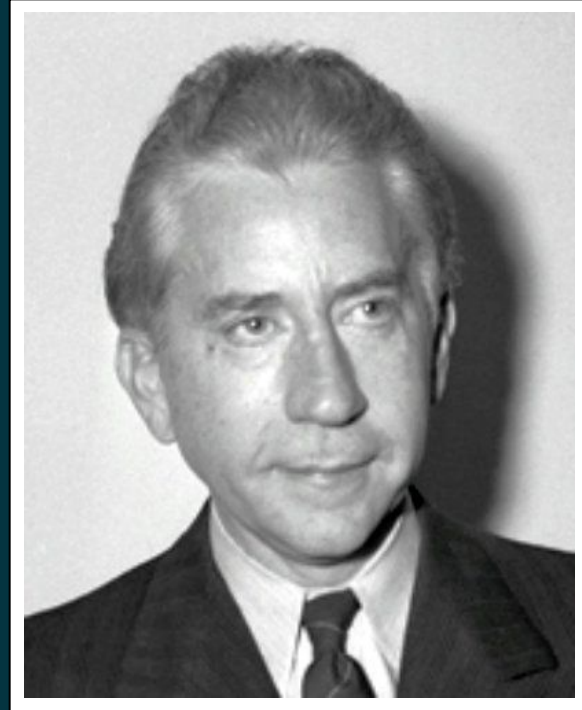
1:2 Vanity of vanities, says the Preacher; vanity of vanities, all is vanity.
