1. GET THE WORD, ANNOUNCE THE WORD

Acts 8:3-5 But Saul was devastating the church, entering house after house; and dragging off men and women, he delivered *them* to prison. Those therefore who were scattered went throughout *the land* announcing the word as the gospel. And Philip went down to the city of Samaria and proclaimed the Christ to them.

John 7:37-38 Now on the last day, the great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes into Me, as the Scripture said, out of his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water.

3. WHAT WE'VE SEEN AND HEARD

Acts 22:15 For you will be a witness to Him unto all men of the things which you have seen and heard.

Acts 9:18, 20 And immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight and rose up and was baptized. And immediately he proclaimed Jesus in the synagogues, that this One is the Son of God.

John 1:40-45 One of the two who heard *this* from John and followed Him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, We have found the Messiah (which translated means Christ). He led him to Jesus... Philip found Nathanael and said to him, We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, wrote, Jesus, the son of Joseph, from Nazareth.
