### I. Living: For to me, to live is Christ

# A. Live in Christ

**Philippians 1:1** Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, To all the saints **in Christ** Jesus who are at Philippi, with the overseers and deacons

### B. Live **as** Christ

**Philippians 3:21** who will <u>transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body</u>, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.

# C. Live **for** Christ

**Philippians 1:12** I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to **advance the gospel** 

## D. Live with Christ

**Philippians 3:10 <u>that I may know him</u>** and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death

### II. Dying: To die is gain

## A. Our gain will be incomparable

**Philippians 3:7-8** But whatever **gain** I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. 8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the **surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord**. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ

## B. Our gain will be eternal

**Philippians 3:7-8** But whatever **gain** I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. 8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and **count them as rubbish**, in order that I may gain Christ

#### C. Our gain will be abundant

**Philippians 1:22-23** If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell. <sup>23</sup> I am hard pressed between the two. **My desire is to depart and be with Christ, for that is far better**.
