I. Our Vision in the Storm

Mark 6:45 Immediately <u>he made his disciples get into the boat</u> and go before him to the other side, to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd.

A. I'm alone

Mark 6:47 And when evening came, the boat was out on the sea, and he was alone on the land.

B. I'm hurting

Mark 6:48 And he saw that they were making headway **<u>painfully</u>**, for the wind was against them. And about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. He meant to pass by them

C. I'm afraid

Mark 6:49-50 but when they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and <u>cried</u> <u>out</u>, ⁵⁰ for they all saw him and were <u>terrified</u>. But immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid."

II. Our Savior's Vision in the Storm

A. Jesus sees

Mark 6:48 And <u>he saw</u> that they were making headway painfully, for the wind was against them. And about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. He meant to pass by them

Psalms 33:13-14 The LORD looks down from heaven; <u>he sees all the children of man</u>; ¹⁴ from where he sits enthroned he looks out on all the inhabitants of the earth

B. Jesus comes

Mark 6:48 And he saw that they were making headway painfully, for the wind was against them. And about the fourth watch of the night <u>he came to them</u>, walking on the sea. He meant to pass by them

C. Jesus speaks

Mark \hat{6}:50 for they all saw him and were terrified. But immediately <u>he spoke to them</u> and said, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid."

Isaiah 30:18 Therefore <u>the LORD waits to be gracious to you</u>, and therefore he exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the LORD is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for him.

III. Our Vision of our Savior in the Storm

Mark 6:48-49 And he saw that they were making headway painfully, for the wind was against them. And about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. <u>He meant to pass by them</u>, ⁴⁹ but when they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and cried out,

Exodus 33:22 and while my glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will cover you with my hand **until I have passed by**.

Hebrews 1:2-3 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. ³ He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high
