Some Definitions

Paul mentions some standard jobs for folks in this first century church. Let's talk about what these job titles mean to them in the first century:

Apostles: Spiritual leaders that lead the leaders of multiple congregations.

Prophets: Speaks on behalf of God, almost always talking from scripture, calling people to action in the present. Pastoral types today.

Teachers: Those who are gifted at studying and revealing scripture to others.

Miracle Workers: Those who's work with others brings on the fruit of the supernatural hand of God.

Healing: Through the supernatural or through skill, those who bring physical and spiritual healing to this world.

Helping: Those gifted to be helpful to others at a high volume.

Leadership: Those having the skills to lead organizations.

Languages: Those who are gifted with innate ability and study, or supernatural ability to speak in and/or understand other languages. Consider the example in Acts 2 where Peter spoke in his own language and 2000 folks from all over the world understood and came to Jesus.

How is it that every local church has a variety of these gifts and talents? Much is God's will or free will in that?
