
SPRING CLEAN UP VOLUNTEERS NEEDED - SATURDAY, MAY 20

Big Idea:

GENEROUS GIVING IS AN ATTITUDE OF THE HEART

GETTING STARTED

What is one lesson about giving you can recall learning from your parents?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. By "sowing and reaping" imagery, is Paul saying that if you give \$100 you will automatically get \$1,000? Why or why not?
- 2. What do you make of the three "all phrases" in verse 8?
- 3. How does generosity effect righteousness, and the ever-widening circles of people giving thanks to God?
- 4. How is giving contagious? How does it reflect God's grace?
- 5. Share a time when you were blessed by the generosity of someone else. Why is being able to receive also important?
- 6. How did you use your "\$20 to Multiply Mission?" What was the best part of the project for you? Or how are you multiplying your resources for use in God's kingdom?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for your generosity in giving your son Jesus to walk this earth and die for our sins. We are truly grateful. May we follow in your footsteps and find joy in giving and generosity for your kingdom work. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read 2 Corinthians, chapters 8 and 9. What is Paul communicating in this passage of Scripture? What principles about giving do you observe? How can God's promise (9:8) enable you to be more generous? To persevere in your work?
