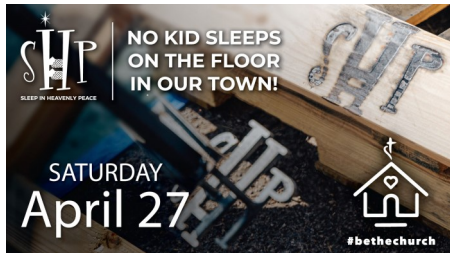

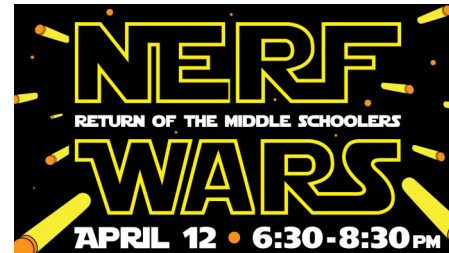

A MINDSET OF GENEROSITY

MESSAGE: GENEROSITY MINDSET Apr 7, 2024
Text: Acts 20:35; 2 Cor. 8:1-11; I Chron. 29:14 Pew Bible page: 925, 967, 361

BIG IDEA: GENEROSITY ISN'T AN AMOUNT; IT'S A MINDSET

“Now I want you to know, dear brothers and sisters, what God in his kindness has done through the churches in Macedonia. They are being tested by many troubles, and they are poor. But they are also filled with abundant joy, which has overflowed in rich generosity. For I can testify that they gave not only what they could afford, but far more. And they did it of their own free will. They begged us again and again for the privilege of sharing in the gift for the believers in Jerusalem. They even did more than we had hoped, for their first action was to give themselves to the Lord.”
2 Corinthians 8:1-5

GETTING STARTED

How easy or difficult is it for you to be generous with your time and resources?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do you learn about the Macedonians from their giving? What would this test of generosity reveal?
2. “You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.” (v.9) What do you think about or feel when you hear the words: generous, grace, or abundance?
3. Share about a time when you received a blessing through someone’s generosity. How did you see God’s faithfulness through that experience?
4. Read I Chronicles 29:14. How does viewing your resources as God’s resources change the way you think about generosity?
5. Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why? What principles about giving did you observe?
6. Talk about your mindset around generosity. What is one shift you could make to have a healthier mindset around your resources?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, you have blessed us in ways we can’t even begin to understand. Thank you for leading the way in generosity and for asking us to do the same. Please show us where our mindsets are keeping us from being a blessing to others, and show us how we can change. Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read 2 Cor. 8:1-11, I Cor 16:1-4, and Romans 15:25-27. What is this collection all about? In light of the struggles in Corinth, why would Paul draw their attention to the Macedonian example? What from Jesus’ example (v.9) prompts you to be generous with your money, time, and energy?
