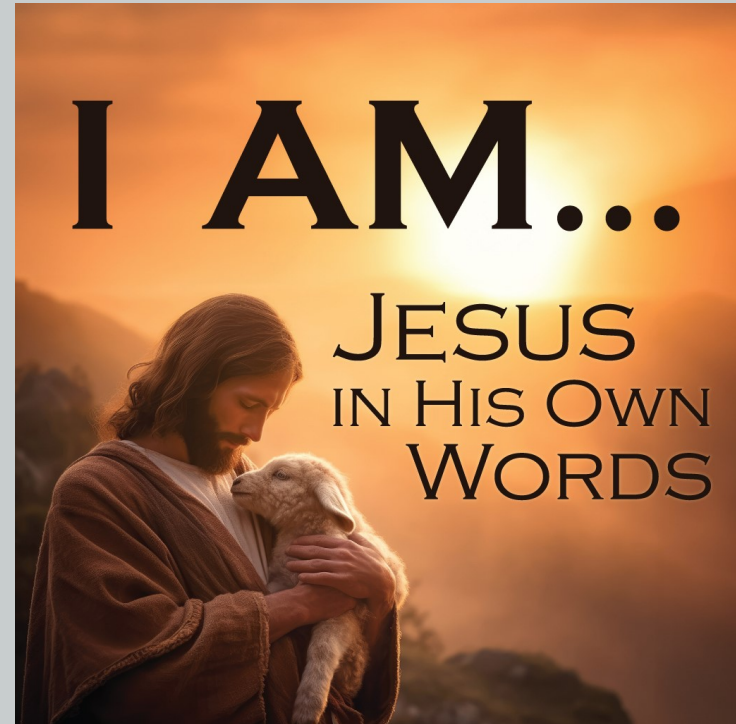



# I AM... JESUS IN HIS OWN WORDS

MESSAGE: I AM... THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE Mar 10, 2024  
Text: John 11: 1-6, 17-45 Pew Bible page: 892-893

**BIG IDEA:** FAITH LOOKS FORWARD, BELIEVING IN WHAT WE CAN'T SEE

## MY NOTES:

“When Jesus arrived at Bethany, he was told that Lazarus had already been in his grave for four days. Bethany was only a few miles down the road, and many of the people had come to console Martha and Mary in their loss. When Martha received word that Jesus was coming, she went to meet him. But Mary stayed in the house. Martha said to Jesus, ‘Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died’... Jesus told her, ‘I am the resurrection and life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying. Everyone who lives in me and believes in me will never die.’”  
John 11:17-21, 25-26 (NLT)

### GETTING STARTED

Describe the sickest you have ever been. How did you get through it?

### REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What kind of relationship did Jesus have with Lazarus and his sisters? Why did Jesus deliberately delay? (v.6)
2. How long had Lazarus been dead by the time Jesus arrived? How would you feel if you were Martha and Mary and you heard that Jesus had finally come?
3. What do you learn about Martha from the way she talks with Jesus in vs. 21-27?
4. When have you been faced with a tough situation that ended up stretching your faith? What would have been different for you if that struggle had been avoided?
5. How do you personally respond to Jesus’ statement and question in vs. 25-26?
6. Where do you, perhaps, need a ‘second chance’ in some area of your life (physically, spiritually, mentally)? Where do you need to ‘look forward’ and choose to praise?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

**PRAYER:** Lord Jesus, thank you for your care for Lazarus and his sisters in this time of great grief in their lives. You felt the emotion of the moment too. Thank you for the promise of everlasting and eternal life forever with you. Help us to trust you in faith for what we can’t see, the hope of resurrection. In Jesus’ name, we pray, Amen.

**GOING DEEPER:** Read John 11:1-57. Why did Jesus raise Lazarus from the dead? What was the purpose of the miracle? Have you ever felt like God was not listening when you prayed? How did you deal with this? How does the way in which Jesus postponed his response to the sisters’ request help you in understanding your own prayer life?
