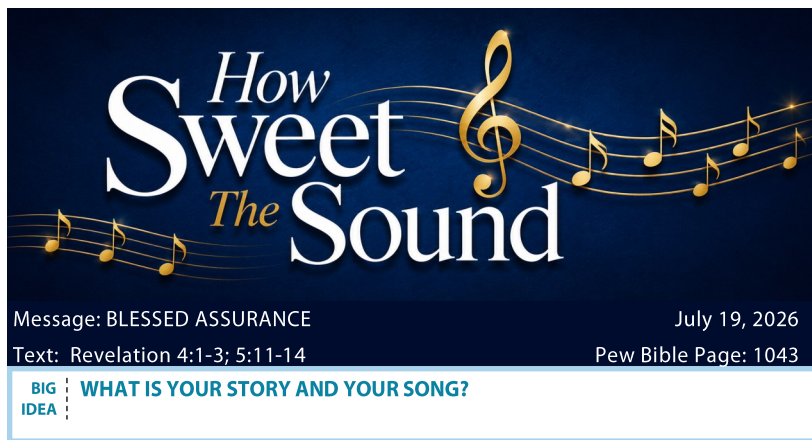

GETTING STARTED

What was the best choir or musical group you have ever heard? What was most memorable?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read the Scripture below. Imagine yourself in this scene. What do you see? Hear? Feel? What impresses you about God?
2. What aspect of God's creation best demonstrates God's glory and power to you? Why?
3. How might this vision of God enhance your worship life? Your everyday life?
4. What stands out to you the most about Fanny Crosby's story? What hardships did she face? How did she respond to them?
5. In light of heaven, what is your STORY and SONG? What gets you through life?
6. "Hope for eternity, urgency for today. I will not leave words unsaid, deeds undone, or hope unshared." What do these words inspire in you? What might you do about it this week?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, you are holy and mighty and worthy of all of our praise. You sit on the throne and we worship you. May we hold the challenges of life in light of eternity. Give us a "song to sing" and a "story to tell." Thank you for Fanny Crosby's story and the testimony of her life. May we find our strength and hope in you. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Revelation chapters 4-6. Imagine being in John's shoes and writing all of this imagery down. What catches your attention? What do you want to know more about? What images or titles are used for Jesus? What brings you awe? What concerns you? Rest in the "Blessed Assurance" of God's eternal provision as a follower of Jesus.
