# REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. In this parable, what were the master's expectations of his servants while he was away?
- 2. What happens to the two servants who doubled their investment? To the servant who hides his talent? On what basis were they rewarded?
- 3. How does the master's treatment of the one-talent servant seem to you: Fair? Harsh? Lenient? Why?
- 4. If the Master returned today, what would he say about how you've used what he gave you? How have you developed it?
- What kind of responsibility do you feel toward God regarding your talents?
- What does sharing your Master's happiness mean to you? How will you use your \$20 to multiply mission?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?
